A resolution has been reached in a civil action regarding the adequacy of disclosures regarding automatic subscription renewal offers advertised by Pleasanton Fitness, LLC, OM Fitness, LLC, Zeus Fitness LLC, Monterey Fitness, LLC, and 10<sup>th</sup> Street Holdings LLC (hereinafter, the “Fitness Evolution Defendants” or “Defendants”).

Current or former California resident subscribers of Fitness Evolution may be eligible for a restitution payment for subscribers who were enrolled in a Fitness Evolution automatic renewal or continuous service plan between June 1, 2011 and September 30, 2015 and who were charged for at least one automatically renewed subscription cycle without their knowledge or consent, or if they requested cancellation or a refund of their subscription, or had a request delayed or denied, such that they paid at least one automatically renewed charge after the request was made. To see if you qualify for a restitution payment, you must submit a Claim Form. To file the claim online, go to [Fitnessrestitution.com](http://Fitnessrestitution.com). You may file a Claim Form by mailing it to People of the State of California v Pleasanton Fitness, LLC, et al., KCC Class Action Services, P.O. Box 43183, Providence, RI 02940-3183.

The deadline to file a claim form is May 19, 2020. All claim forms must be submitted online by May 19, 2020 or postmarked by that date. If you qualify and have not previously been refunded your membership fee, you may receive a refund of up to one month membership that you paid during the relevant period. Depending on the number of valid claims received, you may receive only a partial refund compared to the above amount.
